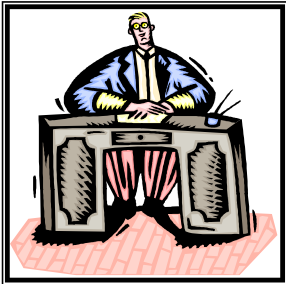

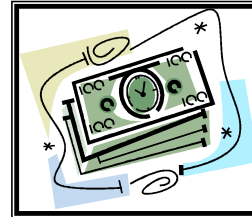

vehicles bogged. This ended up a major operation to extract from the sand.



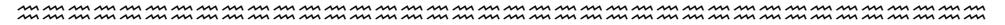
Unfortunately after getting him out it made the way unpassable to the rest of us. Going back looked impossible too, we managed to take a track higher up off the beach to get around

Thank you Murray for a good weekend

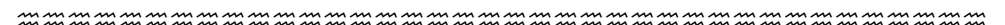

**The Victorian High Country - April 17<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> 2009**

A trip through the Victorian High Country, with some of our most spectacular mountain areas, is an experience of high country huts, breathtaking views and some very challenging four-wheel driving. A trip with an abundance of historical sites.

This area is the Mecca of 4-wheel-driving. The environment is typical high country Victoria, mountains, rivers and eucalypts. Dry and dusty tracks in summer, treacherous slippery tracks in some places after rain. Many opportunities to try out some trout fishing.

Much of the trip may be spent in low ratio and fuel consumption will be higher.

Drinkable water can usually be readily obtained from running rivers at many of the crossing points or camps. Carry enough for your camps at the higher altitude spots.

Lower vehicles will have clearance issues on some tracks; this trip is not for soft roaders and unfortunately, is not suitable for camper trailers.

Fire Ban Season may apply, hence possibly no fires may be permitted. Gas cooking only.

Communications is limited to HF and Satphones for 95% of this trip.

Fuel and food supplies at Omeo, Swifts Creek, Dargo, and Mansfield.

Day 1 Friday - Adelaide to Echuca, camping at a Caravan park or possible bush camping.

Day 2 Saturday - Echuca to Omeo, Camping in Caravan Park.

Day 3 Sunday - Omeo to Tom Groggin camping in Caravan Park This trek includes the Pinnibar track with views of Mt Kosciusko , traveling through ash forests to finally end at Tom Groggin station, with a crossing over the River Murray at the NSW border. (approx 100km)

Day 4 Monday - Tom Groggin to Swifts Creek camping at a caravan park. This trek covers the Davies High Plains, a very popular 4WD destination and rarely visited country area between the Snowy River Valley to the east and the Tambo River to the west. (approx 130km)

Day 5 Tuesday - Day trip to Swifts Creek area. Travel Boomerang spur track, Haunted stream, crossing this stream some 45 times. Visit Victoria mine, site of old mining relics, onto Angora range lookout and back to Swifts Creek for another night. (approx 120km)

Day 6 Wednesday - Swifts Creek to Dargo camping at Dargo Caravan Park. This trek visits the Cassillis Historic Area, site of gold mining operations in the early 1900's., then via Harrison's Cut, visit the monument of Man's best friend, cross over the Dargo River to Dargo. (approx 90km)

Day 7 Thursday - Dargo to Wonnangatta, via Grant Historic Area. This trek covers the Collingwood Spur and exploring some of the old mining sites, the old township of Talbotville including the old cemetery, traveling along the crooked river providing some great views into the valleys either side. Relics of the gold boom this area experienced. Wonnangatta Valley, the jewel of the Alps, Wonnangatta Homestead site and Cemetery provide some stirring memories of life in the 1800's. Camp down by the Wonnangatta River (approx 77km)

Day 8 Friday - Wonnangatta to Sheeppark Flat camping in campgrounds. This trek takes in the Macalister River, the challenging Zeka spur track, Howitt plains past Lovicks hut and the Bluff. The views from Lovick's to the top of King Billy are outstanding. Also travel via the Mitchells historic site, upper Jamieson and Fry's hut. (approx 70km)

Day 9 Saturday - Sheeppark Flat via Mansfield to Bendigo, camping in Caravan Park.

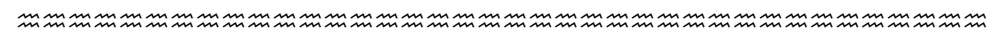
Day 10 Sunday - Bendigo to Adelaide.

**Notes:** This is the proposed plan for this trip at this stage, there may be changes due to environmental, track and weather conditions, covering some distances may prove difficult in wet weather, hence some detours, bypasses etc may also be required, particularly on steep accents and some of the river crossings.

Be prepared to work together in the event of any change of plans and camping locations.
