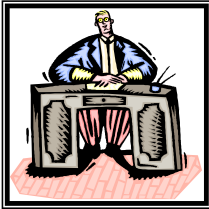

The Adelaide Sunday Mail October 4th 2009 reported the death of an 18 year old male on an end-of-season football trip in Tasmania. In an attempted beach recovery, "...the tow ball and snatch strap came loose, smashing through the rear windscreen..." with fatal results.

### Beachport - Nora Creina Map Amendment New Bypass Track

Commencing in June 2009, with approval from DEH and the Coastal Protection Board, the Wattle Rangers 4WD Club in conjunction with the Millicent Sand Buggy Club have re-opened existing tracks just behind the beach to bypass Buggy Club grounds at Beachport. These tracks had not been used for many years.

The purpose of this bypass is to eliminate the possibility of 4WD vehicles and sand buggies crossing paths. Sand buggies in their club grounds may travel at speeds in excess of 100mph.

A large bulldozer contracted by the Buggy Club for work on their tracks was used to re-cut a 200 metre section of overgrown track. Much work was done clearing and pruning over the following few months.

You are urged NOT to enter into the buggy club grounds at any time. The new section only affects the track between points 15-21 on the Beachport to Nora Creina track.

Track users should also be aware that in August and September DEH laid fox baits on the beach within Beachport Conservation Park. This followed a similar successful exercise in Canunda.

### Original Border Track Section Reopened

The Murray Mallee DEH staff expressed their thanks for the 448 hours of mammoth effort a Ngarkat Conservation Park by 8 FWDSA Clubs on the weekend of April 18th-20th 2009.

Not only was a 1Km section of original track reopened, but tracks were rubbled to assist stabilisation, the chain grader was trialled, steel cable fence was installed using concrete/wood posts, and The Pines campsite was increased in size.

The weekend featured the presentation of a Certificate of Appreciation to Border Track Committee Co-ordinator Sue Linnell for her contribution over many years.

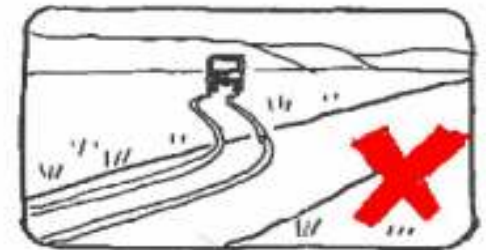

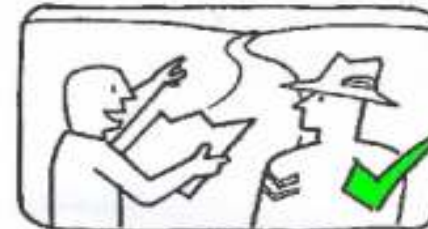

We now find ourselves driving around to the back of the house and look at the steep climb when we will be attempting this after lunch. We finished the mornings drive at the water hole attempting to climb out up the bank with some being successful after a few challenging climbs and driving around before finishing up with a BBQ for lunch ably cooked by Peter and Mike in the shade of the trees. This was a welcome relief from the hot sun especially for the 'POST BOYS' who had been toiling away in the open all morning without any shade.

After the lunch break it was back to the challenging terrain before driving around to attempt the steep incline at the rear of the house where we all congregated successful or not for a final drive for those that wanted to continue and for the rest it was

cheerios all round and a big thankyou to Colin for a most enjoyable day before leaving for home.

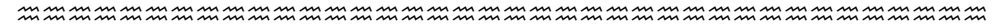

Note from the trip leader.

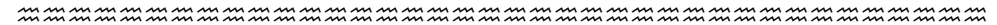

**4WD Driver Tips**

**Cooling systems** - Check radiators, fan blades, hose and belts. Radiators can be internally and externally blocked. Externally mud, dust, grass seeds and bugs, bugs are a major cause of radiator failure. The acid in the bugs cause corrosion in the core. Remember to remove and repaint every twelve months.

**Plastic fan blades** - Every time you perform an under the bonnet inspection, always check the fan. Plastic is prone to crack and can cause major damage if it is left unattended.
