Dear 4WD Adventurers Club,

VEHICLE FRONTAL PROTECTION SYSTEMS / BULL BARS

There is currently no compulsory standard for Vehicle Frontal Protection Systems / bull bars (VFPs) designed and fitted to new vehicles in South Australia.

The Department for Transport, Energy and Infrastructure (DTEI) have been in consultation with the Australian Automotive Aftermarket Association (AAAA) and the Centre for Automotive Safety Research (CASR) regarding improving pedestrian safety in South Australia relating to VFPs.

A recommendation from CASR and the AAAA proposes to introduce state based legislation to mandate all VFPs fitted to all new South Australian vehicles to conform to the Australian Standard 4876.1-2002 (section 1 & 2).

Since the release of the AS 4876 in 2002, both NSW and Victoria introduced a mandate for all new VFPs to comply with this standard. As such, a high percentage of new bull bars currently comply with the standard. However, there remains a minority of manufacturers who continue to supply and market very aggressive bull bars in states such as South Australia with no compulsory standard for VFPs.

Proposed legislation changes to mandate AS 4876 in South Australia will remove aggressive bull bars from the new vehicle marketplace with a view to improve pedestrian impact protection.

In 2008 the AAAA conducted extensive consultation with industry and the community regarding VFP standards. A conclusion of this process provided support for proposed amendments to South Australian Legislation to include a mandate to AS 4876 (section 1 & 2).

It is important to note that there is no proposal to ban VFPs or force their removal in South Australia. The proposed amendment to State legislation simply adds a requirement for all new VFPs to meet a National standard relating to design, installation and crash performance. Ultimately, to improve road safety outcomes for all South Australian road users.

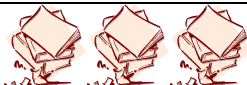

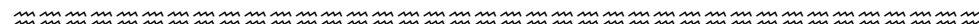
Poonunda Creek Bed Exit
