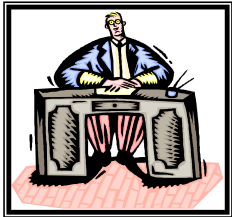

### Club Member 4WD Driver Training

Membership of the **4WD Adventurers Club** enables club members to access both **informal** and **formal** 4WD driver training. New club members often comment that a key reason for their joining a 4WD club is to further develop their 4WD driver skills in a supportive environment with others who share a common interest in 4WD'ing.

**Informal training**, as the name suggests, is provided by knowledgeable and skilled trip leaders, club members or club trainers on an informal "as required" ad-hoc basis during club trips. This may be as simple as a recommendation on appropriate tyre pressures to more complex situations where vehicles require some form of recovery. It is also an ideal environment to practice any formal training that may have been previously undertaken.

**Formal training** is provided by Four Wheel Drive South Australia Driver Training Unit (FWDSA DTU) trainers. This training may be organised directly by the FWDSA DTU (for example see the FWDSA DTU Training section on page 8) or by our club's training co-ordinator (Carl) who develops club training trips based on club member training requirements that have been indicated to him via the training trip registration templates available at club meetings.

Formal training by FWDSA DTU trainers is based upon the theory contained in the FWDSA DTU Reference Manual and is undertaken by following the training checklists contained in the FWDSA DTU Training & Assessment Checklist book. These two books are available together for \$60 from the club training co-ordinator (Carl). The **4WD Adventurers Club** **strongly recommends** that all club members obtain a copy of these two books for their own reference. This is especially the case if they wish to undertake any formal training as the FWDSA DTU trainers will generally expect that trainees are familiar with the theory in the Reference Manual and the method of training in the Training & Assessment Checklist.

The **4WD Adventurers Club** has two qualified FWDSA DTU trainers (Colin & Werner) who generously and regularly give their own time to provide formal training to club members and they each reinforce that it is far more time efficient, practical and purposeful for them to train drivers who have the FWDSA DTU training books. Where other FWDSA DTU trainers are being utilised on club training trips it is unlikely that the other FWDSA DTU trainers will provide training to those who do not have the FWDSA DTU training books.

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### Online Booking System for Mount Remarkable and Innes National Parks

*(The following text has been supplied by DEWNR - Ed.)*

Are you planning a trip to Mount Remarkable National Park or Innes National Park? A new system has been introduced to make it easier and fairer to camp at sites in these parks (Mount Remarkable and Innes National Parks).

**Camp sites must now be booked at [www.parks.sa.gov.au](http://www.parks.sa.gov.au) prior to arrival.**

To book your site please visit [www.parks.sa.gov.au](http://www.parks.sa.gov.au) and follow these steps:

1. Select 'find a park' and find the park you wish to visit.
2. Select camping from the side bar at the left.
3. Select the campground and site at which you wish to stay.
4. Answer the booking questions. You will be asked to enter your current pass number.
5. Select 'buy now'.
6. At checkout fill in your details.

**Note:** If you have a Park Pass + Camping you will not be charged for camping, but the system still requires a credit card number to be entered to complete the transaction.

If you have a Park Pass without camping you will be charged for camping and you will need to enter your credit card number to complete the transaction.

The website includes information to help with your booking, such as:

- Images of individual sites.
- Information on what vehicles are suitable for the site, for example caravan, campervan, tent etc.
- Information on where the site is located in proximity to amenities such as toilets.
- Other site information such as shady site, near creek, fire pit etc.

Once you have completed your booking you will receive a confirmation email with the details of the site you have booked.

The website will only display available camp sites, giving you an indication of how busy it will be on the particular night you wish to book by the number of available sites.

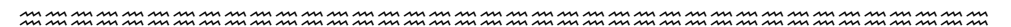

Trip Requirements	Self-sufficient camping. Drop toilet available.
Fuel Requirements	Fuel available in Birdwood and Mannum
Trip Accommodation	Caravan and camper friendly. Fire wood able to be collected on site. Drop Toilets.
Trip Costs	\$55 driving on site, \$10 camping if staying overnight.
Trip Description	Rating 2-3, easy to moderate hill and rock climbs and descents. Beautiful views and walks.
Trip Conditions & Comments	<b>No Pets.</b> <b>If weather too wet this trip will be postponed.</b>



**Pyrenees (Victoria) - 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> October 2014**

Location	Pyrenees Range Trek (Victoria) - ~6 hours east of Adelaide.
Dates	Thursday 2 <sup>nd</sup> October to Monday 6 <sup>th</sup> October. This includes the October Labour Day long weekend.
Trip Leader(s)	Ray Collyer (.)
Trip Starting Point	Adelaide Thursday 2 <sup>nd</sup> October with the trip leader OR Elmhurst on the main road at the 60 km/hr speed sign on Saturday 4 <sup>th</sup> October. Contact the trip leader to arrange an agreed meeting time.
Trip Route	Adelaide to Ararat via Tailem Bend and Horsham and then onto the Pyrenees Range tracks and return. Leave Ararat on the Ararat to Avoca road (Pyrenees Highway) and travel 35kms towards Elmhurst (Adelaide -> Elmhurst ~600km).
Trip Requirements	Standard recovery gear is essential. Totally self-sufficient camping.
Fuel Requirements	As necessary for the Trip Route noted above. Last fuel stop is Ararat. Fuel discount vouchers can be used at the Shell and Caltex Safeway in Horsham and Ararat. Both locations have petrol, diesel and LPG.
Trip Accommodation	Campground is suitable for tents, off-road camper trailers and caravans. The campground will be the base camp for day trips. Fuel will be easily accessible from local towns. Bring plenty of food, water, fuel and a bag of firewood for the first night. Bow saw and chain saw will be useful.
Trip Costs	Driving costs. No camping fees.
Trip Description	The type and grade of driving will depend on the track and weather conditions. Most of the 4WD tracks are of moderate to difficult grade (3-4) to extreme tracks with low range descents. Much care is required if the tracks are wet however extreme tracks can be avoided if need be.
Trip Notes	Last good food and drinking supplies will be at Ararat.
